



Directions to Town Hall 71 Mount Vernon Street

Town Hall is a 19th-century red-brick building with a clock tower at the corner of Mount Vernon and Washington streets. The main entrance is on Mount Vernon Street. The (separate) auditorium entrance is also on Mount Vernon Street. There are entrances to the lower level, including an accessible entrance, in the rear.

From Route 128/195 - Exit 33A (Rt. 3) in Burlington
Follow Cambridge Street (Rt. 3) through Woburn Four Corners and past Mahoney's Garden Center to the second set of traffic lights. Turn left onto Church Street and continue to the rotary in Winchester Center. Continue under the overpass and straight onto Mount Vernon Street. At the end of the block, Town Hall is on your right.

Route 128, Exit 35 (Rt. 38 Main Street.) in Woburn

Follow Rt. 38 (Main Street.) for 3 miles through Woburn into Winchester. At the lights at the intersection of Main Street, Lake Street (to the right) and Skillings Road (to the left) in front of the Stop & Shop, turn left onto Skillings Road. At the second set of lights, Town Hall is on the right-hand, opposite corner.

Route 128 - Exit 36 (Washington Street.) in Woburn

Take a right off the exit ramp onto Washington Street and follow Washington Street for 4 miles. After the 6th set of traffic lights (5-way intersection) the Town Hall is ahead of you on the corner.

Route 93 - Exit 33 (Winchester/Fellsway)

Follow South Border Road until the first set of traffic lights when the road becomes Mount Vernon Street. Continue on Mount Vernon Street to the next set of lights. Town Hall is at the intersection.

Route 3 (from Arlington)

Follow Mystic Street which becomes Cambridge Street in Winchester. At the first set of lights, turn onto Church Street and continue to the rotary in Winchester Center. Continue under the overpass and straight onto Mount Vernon Street. At the light, Town Hall is on your right.

Parking

There is a parking lot facing Town Hall across Mount Vernon Street. There is also parking between the Town Hall and library, with handicapped spaces near each of the doors to the lower level.
