direction, the Harvard Wind Ensemble has premiered Cumba Cumbakín byTania León, and most recently Big Bertha by Libby Larsen, both commissioned for the Harvard Wind Ensemble. The Sunday Jazz Band has premiered arrangements of the music of Jim Hall,Tadd Dameron, Hank Jones, James Moody and Lee Morgan. Olson has served as Interim Conductor of the Cambridge Symphony Orchestra, Guest

Conductor of the Metropolitan Wind Symphony. He received degrees from Concordia College in Moorhead, MN and the University of Minnesota and is an active trumpet performer as a member of the Metropolitan Wind Symphony and the New Sousa Band.

#### **About the Middlesex Concert Band**






Originally founded in the 1950s as a marching band, the group evolved into a concert band in the spring of 1975 with its first concert at Memorial Hall in Melrose. 
