Mark Olson, Director of Harvard Band and Wind Ensemble, conducts the Harvard Wind Ensemble, serves as an advisor to the Harvard University Band and administrates all aspects of the band program at Harvard. He has also conducted the Sunday Jazz Band. Under his direction, the Harvard Wind Ensemble has commissioned and premiered Big Bertha by Libby Larsen, Cumba Cumbakin by Tania León, and Global Suite for Winds and Percussion, by David Amram. Mark has served as the interim conductor of the Cambridge Symphony Orchestra and guest conducted the Metropolitan Wind Symphony. He is currently the Director of the Middlesex Concert Band and the New England Brass Band. Olson received degrees from Concordia College in Moorhead, MN and the University of Minnesota. An active trumpet performer and soloist, he is currently the Principal Trumpet of the Metropolitan Wind Symphony and performs with the New Sousa Band.



About the Middlesex Concert Band

The Middlesex Concert Band is a nonprofit community band based in Wakefield, Massachusetts. The band regularly performs concerts across the North Shore and strives to bring affordable entertainment to those communities. Band members include amateur musicians and music educators from throughout Northeast Massachusetts and Southern New Hampshire.

Originally founded in the 1950s as a marching band, the group evolved into a concert band in the spring of 1975 with its first concert at Memorial Hall in Melrose. Since then, it has become one of the area's outstanding community musical organizations, performing in various indoor venues from September through June and presenting a number of free outdoor concerts during the summer months.

The Middlesex Concert Band is chartered to provide an enjoyable listening experience, while helping to educate members of the band and the audience with exposure to a broad variety of music.
